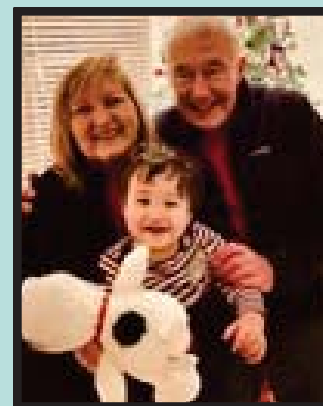
Jane and Ken Belmore
